MEMBER CODE OF CONDUCT

In order to promote a safe and welcoming environment for our members and guests, we ask all individuals visiting the Monroe County YMCA to act appropriately while exhibiting the character values of respect, responsibility, caring, and honesty.

RESPECT

- Cell phones, tablets, and cameras are strictly prohibited in the locker rooms.
- Photo taking is prohibited in the locker rooms.
- Appropriate attire must be worn at all times (see area specific policies).
- Refrain from sexually explicit conversations or sexual contact with another person.
- Loitering is prohibited in areas not intended for this type of use inside the Monroe County YMCA or surrounding property.
- The Monroe County YMCA is a smoking, tobacco, and e-cigarette free environment.

RESPONSIBILITY

- You may not open-carry or conceal any objects that can be considered a weapon.
- Using, possessing, or being under the influence of illegal drugs or alcohol in the YMCA, on the YMCA grounds, or at a YMCA event is strictly prohibited.

CARING

- Physical contact in an angry or threatening way, harassment or intimidation by words, gestures, or body language will not be permitted on YMCA property.
- Please pick up after yourself and leave each area of the facility in the same or better condition than when you arrived.

HONESTY

- All members and guests must check in at the Welcome Center prior to accessing the YMCA.
- Granting access to the facility to unauthorized individuals is prohibited.
- Theft and the destruction of property is not tolerated.

Any member, program participant, or guest who is in violation of the Code of Conduct will be subject to consequences including, but not limited to: removal from a program or suspension/termination of membership.
