## **COMPETE FOR THE CAUSE CORPORATE CHALLENGE**

### **FREE THROW CONTEST**

1. Participants will attempt 10 free throws with 1 warm-up shot.
2. Any competitors who have hit all 10 free throws will continue until they miss.
3. Competitors who have hit 9 out of 10 free throws will shoot three more regardless of making or missing to help break possible ties.

#### **PLEASE NOTE:**

If a shooter goes 9 for 10 and then makes their 3 extra free throws, they'll still finish behind someone who makes their first 10 and then misses immediately.

4. Separate male and female divisions will be awarded prizes. Males must use an official men's basketball while females may use either size.
5. A shooter who crosses the line receives one warning without penalty. Going over the line a second time will result in an automatic missed free throw.
6. Age divisions: 29 & under, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, and 60 & up.
